





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EAT | notable places we've enjoyed, but certainly not the only options.

- North Channel Brewing Company | Great atmosphere with local beer and pub food. Limited sidewalk seating.
- <u>Taco 'Bout It Mexican Fusion</u> | In spite of being from Chicago with taqueria's galore, we were pleasantly surprised with how much we love the food! Menu is minimal, but the flavor and bites are huge! Special Margaritas and Michigan brews on tap... you can't go wrong. Fun atmosphere and sidewalk dining too.
- <u>The Fillmore</u> | What can we say wood fired pizza, burgers and spirits!
- <u>Diner-21</u> | A.K.A. M-31 Diner, this is the perfect breakfast/brunch diner with great service! Outdoor patio too. For some reason, the sign in front say Captains Corner; consider it a Manistee staple sign ☺.
- <u>TJ's Pub</u> | A classic in the historic Ramsdell Inn.
- <u>The Painted Lady Saloon</u> | Unique and fun saloon, comfort food, outdoor eating.
- <u>Big Al's Pizza</u> | A regional pizza favorite with subs, sandwiches, and Mexican food to boot. Outdoor patio seating too.
- <u>Bluefish Kitchen + Bar</u> | A nice place for finer dining with outdoor patio seating.
- La Riviera Mexican Grill | Very traditional cantina style food and menu.
- <u>Chopo's Northside Bar</u> | Supposed to have great burgers and fish. Just up the street, so we'll have to try it.
- <u>Knickers Restaurant & Pub</u> | Inside the Manistee Golf & Country Club, it's not fancy or pretentious, and has an award winning (and great) all you can eat Friday Night Fish Fry! Prices are very reasonable.
- <u>Bungalow Inn</u> | Another Manistee favorite with a well-rounded menu, laidback atmosphere, and bar with tv's.
- <u>Goody's Juice and Java</u> | Juice, coffee, breakfast, and sandwiches.
- <u>The Outpost</u> | A high end outfitters/clothing store, yet with a locally roasted and brewed coffee and tea shop.
- <u>The Daily Bakehouse</u> | Fresh baked breads and limited sweet treats. Check out their Facebook page every day to see what they're making.

SAMPLE DAY TRIPS

35 m | ARCADIA DUNES: THE CS MOTT NATURE PRESERVE has several hiking trails through the woods to the beach and dunes (one is an accessible trail), depending on your interest. We went through woods, grasslands, and dunes to experience the view from atop! You can see Frankfort if you look north. On the way there, we stopped at the Arcadia Marsh Nature Preserve to enjoy the extensive boardwalk over the marsh to the other side. Afterwards, you could easily travel north an extra 15 minutes for food or snacks in Frankfort!

1 hr 15 m | SLEEPING BEAR DUNES NATIONAL LAKESHORE is a breathtaking mirage of dunes and the Lake that makes you think "we're almost there!" Check it out on a cooler or Fall day as it is a work-out. Afterwards, grab a bite in Empire, travel a hint north to Glen Arbor, or backtrack to Frankfort.

50 m | FRANKFORT is an idyllic beach town to grab food and drinks (try Storm Cloud Brewing Company). Save room for ice cream from the many creameries in a 1-mile stretch! Enjoy it as you walk to the beach.

1 hr 30 m | LELAND'S HISTORIC FISHTOWN is picturesque in every way where you must try its divine whitefish dip! Enjoy the food, shopping, wine tasting rooms, and if you're feeling adventurous, boat to South Manitou Island. This is a destination trip, so you could couple it with a visit to Traverse City, Glen Arbor, or Northport. Otherwise, to break it up, stop in Beulah situated on beautiful Crystal Lake to grab a snack or food. We enjoyed Five Shores Brewing in their outdoor space.

4 h RT + stops | Explore Northwest Michigan using M-22 as a guide. Stop along charming lakeside towns or drive to Northport, the most northern peninsula of this NW region. Loop southeast and enjoy dinner in hip and scenic Traverse City before heading back to Manistee. This is definitely an all-day trip!
